INTRODUCTION

We congratulate you on the purchase of your BRISTON watch and thank you for your confidence.

BRISTON is celebrating its 10th anniversary! To mark this unique occasion, the Brand has decided to launch its first Streamliner Urban automatic chronograph.

Made in Switzerland, edited & numbered to 50 pieces for each dial, the new Streamliner URBAN 10th anniversary is a pure concentrate of BRISTON know-how.

We invite you to consult the instructions for use and wish you much pleasure with your BRISTON watch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The BRISTON watch must be serviced regularly to ensure that it runs smoothly.

Service intervals vary according to the model, the climate and the care given to the watch by its owner.

As a general rule, we recommend that you follow the steps below to keep your watch in perfect condition for as long as possible.

> Temperatures: avoid temperatures above 0/100°F; -20/+40°C or extreme environments.


> Avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight, contact with water and steam to prevent deformation or discolouration.

> Avoid contact with alcohol, perfumes, detergents and cosmetics to prevent corrosion.

> Chronograph buttons: do not press any watch or chronograph button underwater to prevent water from entering the mechanism.

> Tightening the crown: check that the crown is in the normal position to prevent water from entering the mechanism.

> Check the ATM level of your model so that you know when to use your watch (5 ATM = 50 metres depth - 330 feet).

| 5 ATM / 50 m | 10 ATM / 100 m | 20 ATM / 200 m 30 ATM/ 300 m |
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As a reminder, your BRISTON watch is only suitable for activities where water is used moderately, such as washing hands or showering, as well as recreational activities such as surfing, swimming, sailing and other water sports.

NOT suitable for diving.

FIRST USE

Your **Streamliner Urban Chronograph Anniversary** is equipped with an automatic movement. Before adjusting the watch, the movement must be wound.

To do this, turn the crown counter-clockwise. (approximately 30 turns).

The small seconds at 9 o'clock start to move and the movement is wound.

Once worn, the oscillating weight inside the movement ensures that your watch is wound regularly according to the movement of your wrist.

Your Swiss chronograph allows you to measure periods from a few seconds to 12 hours.

Located on the inner ring, it is also equipped with a tachymeter scale that lets you measure the speed of a moving body over one kilometer.

SETTING YOUR BRISTON WATCH



a) Setting the time

1. Gently pull the crown out to its 2nd position.
2. Turn the crown to set the hour and minute hands.
3. The movement restarts when the crown is pushed back into its normal position against the case of your watch.



b) Setting the date and day of the week

1. Gently pull the crown out to its 1st position.
2. Turn the crown clockwise to set the date. If the date is set between approximately 9 p.m. and 1 a.m., it may not change the next day.
3. Keep the crown in the same position, then turn the crown counter-clockwise to set the day of the week.
4. Push the crown back into its normal position against the watch case.



c) Using the Chronograph

1. The chronograph is started and stopped each time button A is pressed.
2. To reset the chronograph, simply press button A again and then press button B once.

WARRANTY

Thanks to the BRISTON warranty, any BRISTON watch subject to the repair of any manufacturing defect will be repaired free of charge. The warranty certificate must be duly completed, sealed and signed by the authorized BRISTON dealer.

Each BRISTON watch is covered by a 2-YEAR INTERNATIONAL WARRANTY against defects in materials and workmanship. This warranty covers all parts, with the exception of the battery and the other items mentioned above.

Warranty extension:

If the customer digitally completes the certification and authentication system, the warranty is extended to 3 years. In fact, we have introduced a new guarantee card that we have been placing in every BRISTON box since June 2020.

The following events or items are not covered by the BRISTON warranty:

> any damage resulting from inadequate or insufficient care, accident or normal wear and tear;

> the watch dial, mineral glass, case, bracelet, battery, strap loops or any other accessory sold with the watch or contained in the packaging;

> any claim relating to damage or injury caused directly or indirectly by wearing a BRISTON watch;

> functional failure of the watch due to battery depletion;

> loss of water resistance due to contact with water over 100 metres OR loss of water resistance due to the use of a watch button or chronograph under water OR damage caused by the use of alcohol or detergent OR significant damage or corrosion to the watch.

> Customers requesting additional services or who are unable to present a valid warranty certificate will be invoiced the service fee by BRISTON.

BRISTON will not be liable for > any handling of the BRISTON watch by unauthorized persons (e.g. battery replacement, maintenance or repair) or if the watch is altered in its original condition beyond BRISTON's control.

All of the above information has been recorded as technical information and is subject to BRISTON's final approval. Any cases not covered by the above list will be dealt with by endorsement.

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We are not responsible for any damage caused by the possession or use of the watch.

In the event of exchanging a watch, BRISTON will do its utmost to satisfy you & exchange it identically.

However, BRISTON cannot guarantee exactly the same print or colour, particularly on «tortoiseshell» effects, as cellulose acetate is unique and «hand-made».

If the watch fails due to a material or manufacturing defect, please return it to us. Please enclose the completed warranty card (with shop stamp) and proof of purchase with your watch, clearly indicating the nature of the defect. This limited warranty is void if the defect is due to misuse or abuse of the watch.
